AT KGV

Over the two years of the course, for your written exam you will study two set texts and get the chance to make several theatre trips to experience professional performances.

For your practical exams, you will produce two pieces of theatre, both based on the work of a theatre practitioner.

In your first year you will create a devised piece which is marked by your teacher.

In your second year you will create three pieces of theatre based on selected texts, your influenced one will be performed for an external examiner. Both of these will be accompanied by a piece of written coursework.

Expert staff will be on hand to advise you and to help you prepare your audition pieces for drama school or university.
